Program: Lowell's Boat Shop Graham McKay

Graham McKay is the master boat builder and Executive Director at Lowell's Boat Shop, a working museum located in Amesbury's Point Shore neighborhood.

He will take us from founder Simeon Lowell in 1793 to today's mission of preserving and perpetuating the art and craft of wooden boat building. Lowell's Boat Shop is the birthplace of the dory, a traditional boat used widely in the fishing industry over the past two centuries.

Program: Connections to Newbury Christopher Childs

Chris Child is Senior Genealogist at Newbury Street Press at NEHGS and editor of the magazine's genetics column. He has authored, co-authored or co-edited four books and written many articles for NEHGS publications and the Mayflower Descendant.
